SEED Teaching Games

ALL of the games that **SEED** presents are printed on Earth friendly 100% recycled cardboard, non-toxic vegetable based printing inks and/or other non-polluting materials!

The game boards are printed on 100% kenaf (a tree free annual plant) and the instruction booklets are printed on paper made from non-deinked, 100% post-consumer recycled paper. The game cards (and white paper wrap for the box) are printed on a paper made from a combination of kenaf, post-consumer recycled paper and a small amount of virgin wood pulp. All printing was done with vegetable based ink. Wooden dies and pieces are stained with vegetable based dyes.


Excessive packaging and one-use disposable items represent a considerable portion of the solid waste problem in the country. Please consider the amount of water and energy used to produce these items and the pollution that results from the manufacturing process. Clearly, packaging and its disposal represent a major threat to our health and environment.

Detailed Description

Energy Hogs is a one to two hour board game designed to provide an entertaining context for middle and high school kids (6th through 12th graders) and their families to learn energy conservation. While playing Energy Hogs, your objective is to make your home as energy-efficient as possible by changing your behavior and by making careful investments in new products and services. Game cards include concepts, facts, and behaviors that kids can follow in order to conserve energy at home. Players practice their reading and math skills as they play the game, learning useful vocabulary and calculating payback ratios. *Includes a teachers manual.*

Cleanup! is a three to six player card game designed to provide an entertaining context for high school and university students and their families to learn about the most important pollution problems and solutions. We created this one to two-hour card game to inform citizens about the relative importance of various categories of pollution in the air, in the water, and on land, and the available solutions to these problems. While playing Cleanup! your objective is to earn victory points by cleaning up as many local pollution problems, without ignoring the global environmental problems that require cooperation to solve. *Includes a teachers manual.*



Scavenger Hunt



Discover, record, compare, contrast, and recognize natural objects as you look for 12 mystery clues that will then be uncoded and then unscrambled to form a phase. This game also develops teamwork and sportsmanship while learning about nature. Have fun and learn by being fully engaged.



Barry Weinbrom taught science in the New York City Board of Education from 1968-2001. Mr. Weinbrom taught general science at the middle school level for 28 years and taught biology and environmental science in the high school 7 years. He is now an educator for Green Games and the founder of ASAP. He also:

- Developed the "Marriage of the Elements" a presentation for middle school students that presents 21 chemical concepts.
- Developed the CCSP Cooperative Community Science Program, where students in pairs investigated science in the stores and businesses of their school community.
- Developed "SMAW" Learning About Recycling", a project that integrated science, math, art and writing to help the community learn about the importance of buying recycled products and selling them.
- Developed "SciMat3" Scientists, Mathematicians and Teachers for Tomorrow Today. This is a mentoring program in which older youngsters teach hands on science program to elementary school students.
- Developed the *Millennium Project* to celebrate 100 years of science achievement. Ten schools submitted their scientists research reports, which we displayed in John Jay's Hall of Science.
- Was cited in the New York Post as One of NY's Outstanding Educators
- Was an Adjunct Professor, King Community College Science Dept.
